Jogger finds lion cub



- 1 A jogger running through a field in the central Netherlands got a surprise on Sunday when an abandoned lion appeared on the route. The cub – which is believed to be four months old – was found in a small cage outside the city of Utrecht. It was taken to the Lion Foundation in the northern Netherlands after being examined by a vet, according to public broadcaster NOS. Local police have made a public appeal for information on its owner. It was certainly not business as usual for a force on patrol in Tienhoven, a village about 10km to Utrecht's north. On Twitter, they wrote: "This morning, colleagues received a very peculiar report in Tienhoven. Who left the animal behind?"
- 2 Vet Peter Klaver told the NOS reporter that he was shocked when he arrived at the scene because the cage he found was unsuitable and the cub could easily have escaped. "In the end it was possible to put the lion, the cage and everything into the car, so it wasn't necessary to stun it." Police said they wanted to hear from "anybody who had recently bought a lion" or anyone who could help with information about this particular cub.

Club Statement Derby County



- 1 Manager Derby County FC: “As a club, we cannot, and do not, ignore the actions of a small group of players on Tuesday evening.” The players were out as part of a planned team-building dinner with staff. The majority of them acted responsibly and left at around 8pm. A small group of three continued drinking into the night. They also ignored the opportunity to be driven home using cars provided by the club, and chose to drive home themselves.
- 2 A drunk-driving car crash followed. One of the players suffered a serious knee injury that will prevent him from playing until the end of the season. The players involved in the incident on Tuesday evening will be subject to a serious internal investigation into their professional behaviour. But over and above any punishment they receive, they will have to take part in community service for several days.
- 3 “We have been very clear about our attitude towards alcohol. The players know that during the season they are permitted a drink together as a group in a controlled environment. Those involved in Tuesday’s incident know they will pay a heavy price for their actions, but also that we will support them with their rehabilitation back into the team. We will be using this situation to redouble our efforts in highlighting the dangers posed by alcohol.”

- 1 A British Columbia library said there was something unusual about a recently returned book – it was 42 years overdue. Vancouver Island Regional Libraries said a copy of *Wilderness Living* by Bernt Berglund was put into the drop box Monday at the Courtenay Library. The pink stamp card inside the cover shows it was last checked out from the Union Bay branch in 1979.
- 2 “It’s really a mystery as to where the book was for the last 42 years,” library spokesman David Carson told the Coast Mountain News. “The book is in great condition after 42 years. It smells good, its corners are crisp, its pages are nice and sharp,” Carson said.
- 3 Carson said the book would have summed up to a \$3,442 late fee if the library wouldn’t have had a maximum fine of \$7.50. The library is hosting a contest on its Facebook page, inviting commenters to make up their own story about where the book has been for the past 42 years. Three winners will be selected Monday and will win a little present.

But he got disappointed, because Mr. Kaor did not have any answers. Well, he did, but they made no sense at all. There is no real reason why he has been writing the letters all those years. He has never been to the Netherlands and does not know the hotel. Mr. Kaor explained that he was born in the ‘Year of the Mouse’. The Japanese word for mouse is ‘Nezumi’ and when pronounced in Japanese it kind of sounds like ‘the Netherlands’. Also, Mr. Kaor was born on the 22nd. People on Twitter loved it, with some calling Schremp's daughter a genius.

Monkey business

- 1 A monkey has been caught on film doing something extraordinary. He smashed the window of its zoo enclosure with a piece of rock. The caged monkey was filmed at the Zhengzhou Zoo in Central China's Henan on 20 August. The video of this amazing stunt went viral after it was shared online, getting more than 17 million views. Visitors watched on in shock as the monkey broke the enclosure's boundary, shattering the glass of the display wall and making the entire pane of glass crack.
- 2 Zoos are usually a pretty safe environment to watch animals. When you're admiring some lions that could rip you to shreds in seconds, there's always a fence or glass panel between you and any danger. Well, that's unless the animal has somehow managed to sharpen a rock so that it can bash it against the window of its enclosure, completely shattering the glass - as this monkey did. While it's not clear to the zoo keepers if anything had triggered the animal's unusual actions, the monkey could be seen standing near the glass wall holding the big rock with both hands, before it started to repeatedly hit the window with the sharpened object.
- 3 Mind you, the incident may have sufficiently freaked out tourists, but the little monkey was also scared by its own strength, as he was running off frightened in the opposite direction. Tourist Mr. Wang recalled: "The monkey was sharpening some stones, then started hitting the glass with it. The monkey ran away, but it came back to take another look and even touched the cracks he had made."
- 4 Zhengzhou Zoo staff member Tian Shuliao told local media: "When we feed walnuts to other monkeys, they only know to bite it. However this monkey is unlike other monkeys. This one knows how to use tools to break walnuts. But it had never hit the glass window before. This is the first time."

- 1 Howard Kirby (64) from Michigan bought a second-hand couch from Habitat for Humanity for \$70. He routinely shops in this store and was picking up items for his man cave. After a few weeks of finding the couch very uncomfortable, he and his daughter-in-law Diana decided to unzip the cushion covers and look inside. They were flabbergasted to find \$43,000 in cash inside a box.
- 2 Kirby spoke with a lawyer who told him he had no legal duty to return it. But he said his faith got the better of him. "The Holy Spirit just came over me and said, 'No, that's really not yours'," he said. He often thought what he would do if he found a large amount of unmarked cash and that now he is pleased to say he has a good conscience. "I still have to pinch myself to make sure I'm not dreaming or something," he said. So Kirby and Diana took the money in a box back to the store where the couch was bought and asked them to track down the person who donated it.
- 3 The second-hand store found out the item was donated to them by Amy Newberry whose grandfather originally owned it but recently died. She had no idea the money was there when she gave it to the charity store after his death. She admitted that her family would have burned the couch if the store hadn't taken it in. This week, she returned to the store for Kirby to hand the cash back over to her. "It belonged to her, and I'm glad I was able to give it back", Howard Kirby said.

Mumbai traffic lights



- 1 Police in India have come up with a smart plan to cut noise pollution – by making vehicles wait longer for traffic lights to go green if they honk their horns too loudly. Fed up with the buzz from car horns in their city, Mumbai Police conducted a trial at the end of last year in which decibel meters were connected to traffic light poles. If the meters registered noise levels of 85 decibels or over, the lights were reset and stayed red for longer.
- 2 As in several other Indian cities, traffic lights in Mumbai display countdown timers. Pranay Ashok, a police spokesman, told CNN that the experiment took place at a few junctions for 15 minutes a day. He said a further trial – at 10 locations – will be carried out next month. The police hope the concept will then be rolled out to the entire traffic management system.
- 3 Commenting on a video of the initiative that Mumbai Police posted on Twitter at the end of January, Ashok said it showed “the ill effects of this noise pollution.” The video begins with the police describing Mumbai as “the honking capital of the world,” before stating that they had been eager to do something about the problem. In the clip, police name their creation “The Punishing Signal” and offer the following warning to motorists: “Feel free to honk if you don’t mind waiting.”
